A simple, low cost step to expanding use of your ITSO smart passes, Unisync is a new concept for integrating contactless cards with most legacy desktop applications. Known as “middleware”, Unisync facilitates a rapid migration from the use of barcode and mag-stripe cards towards contactless technology.

How does it work?

During the registration process within the Leisure or Library application, the card is offered up to the reader and Unisync places the data encoded on the card into the currently selected text field in the active screen.

When the cardholder returns and offers their card to the dedicated ENCTS reader, the Library or Leisure system will recognise the pass holder and log their attendance.

Our dedicated readers support a variety of proximity cards: Mifare Classic, Mifare Ultralight, Mifare 4K, Mifare Pro and Pro X, JCOP 30, JCOP 31, DesFire. Optional: Philips I-CODE, Texas Instrument HF-I and more.

Unisync supports only GemTAG x501 and x501U readers.
